2018 SAVAGE RIVER RECREATIONAL WHITEWATER RELEASE INFORMATION



The Savage River, home of the 1972 and 1992 US Whitewater Olympic Team Trials and the 1989 World Whitewater Championships, is a challenge for experienced whitewater kayakers, canoeists, & rafters. Garrett College will again sponsor these Savage River Recreational Whitewater Release events this year, in cooperation with Verso Luke Mill, The Maryland Department of Natural Resources, the Upper Potomac River Commission, and the US Army Corps of Engineers. **Water Conditions Permitting**, the Upper Potomac River Commission will provide three water releases. The following days/dates for these releases are: **Saturday, June 2nd, Sunday, July 1st, and Saturday, September 29th, 2018**. Garrett College volunteers will be on site to assist you. **A waiver must be read and completed, with NO ALTERATIONS**. Registration begins at 8:30 AM. When driving along the Savage River Road, **PLEASE TAKE IT SLOW** (35 mph speed limit) – the roads are narrow with no room to move over, due to sheer rock walls on one side and a steep embankment on the other.

Directions: Find your way to Bloomington, Maryland, located on MD Route 135, in the Southeast corner of Garrett County, Maryland. The Savage River Road turns West off of Route 135, near the confluence of the Savage River and the North Branch Potomac River. Follow the Savage River Road for approximately 4 miles to the ASI/Garrett College Registration Canopy.
